

Ensim® WEBppliance™ (LS) Installer for Advanced Users

Introduction

Earlier versions of WEBppliance™ (LS) required users to run the WEBppliance Installation Wizard to download the WEBppliance Installer script and install or upgrade WEBppliance.

Beginning with WEBppliance 3.5.20, advanced users can opt for text-based WEBppliance installation or upgrade by running the WEBppliance Installer script `LWPIInstaller_txt.sh` at the command prompt.

You can use the script to:

- Install WEBppliance on a Red Hat® Linux® 7.3 server
- Upgrade an existing WEBppliance

The script can be downloaded from Ensim's FTP server, ftp://ftp.ensim.com/download/webppliance/linux/Pro/3.5.20/LWPIInstaller_txt.sh. You must pass the parameters listed in Table 1 to the script when you run the command.

Table 1. Script parameters

Parameters	Value	Description
<code>--ftp_server</code>	URL of the FTP server Example: <code>ftp://ftp1.example.com</code>	The FTP server from where the WEBppliance installation files will be downloaded. If you have configured a local FTP server, specify the local FTP server URL. The default FTP server is ftp://ftp.ensim.com . This is an optional parameter.
<code>--no-puc</code>	None	The Pre-upgrade Checker is skipped before the upgrade. This is an optional parameter.
<code>--no-quotacheck</code>	None	No validation will be performed on existing WEBppliance quotas. This is an optional parameter.

Table 1. Script parameters (continued)

Parameters	Value	Description
--email	Email address Example: admin@example.com	The email address at which messages (success or error) will be sent.
--cdrom	Yes/yes/Y/y. Indicates that the Ensim WEBppliance CD-ROM will be used to obtain the WEBppliance installation files. No/no/N/n. Indicates that an FTP server will be used to obtain the WEBppliance installation files.	Indicates whether the Ensim WEBppliance CD-ROM will be used to install or upgrade WEBppliance.
--help	None	Displays help on the command parameters.



Procedure: To install or upgrade WEBppliance:

- 1 Log on to the WEBppliance server on which you want to install or upgrade WEBppliance.
- 2 Download the Installer script from Ensim's FTP server to the WEBppliance server.
- 3 Run the script by typing the following command at the prompt. Refer to [Table 1 on page 1](#) for parameter descriptions.

```
#sh LWPIInstaller_txt.sh -- --ftp_server=<ftp_server_url> --no-puc --no-quotacheck  
--email=<email_address> --cdrom=<yes/no>
```



Important: The `LWPIInstaller_txt.sh` script is a wrapper that embeds the WEBppliance Installer script. The additional `--` is necessary to indicate to the wrapper that all parameters successive to `--` must be passed on to the embedded Installer script.

Example

In the example, the command installs WEBppliance by downloading the WEBppliance installation files from Ensim's FTP server.

```
#sh LWPIInstaller_txt.sh -- --ftp_server=ftp://ftp.ensim.com --no-puc --no-quotacheck  
--email=admin@example.com --cdrom=n
```
